My Time: Please note that classes on Friday mornings will not commence until 9.30am. This is to allow further professional learning time for teachers. Students are still very welcome to attend school from 8.00am and they will be supervised in a similar manner to morning tea and lunchtime. A number of student groups will also meet during this time.

Form Time: Each day begins with Vertical Form Time. All students belong to a vertical form class comprising of students from Years 7 to 13. The vertical group focuses on attendance and administration matters.

WRO: Each day ends with WRO time. This stands for Warning/Report/Out. This is the College's behavioural management system. If a student is placed on Report they are required to meet with the teacher at the end of the day to discuss the issue. All other students are able to go home at 2.50pm.
