SUPERVISED SENIOR STUDY

The Covid-19 lockdown resulted in some changes in school practice that we would like to continue. One of these relates to Year 11, 12 & 13 students who have a study class in Block 1 (the start of the school day) or Block 3 (after lunch).

Where a student has timetabled Supervised Senior Study during Block 1 or Block 3, they can elect to study at home, if they have parental permission.

Block 1 is 8:40am - 10:05am

Students may arrive at school by 10:05 am and sign in at the office before going directly to their Religious Education class.

Block 3 is 1:25pm - 2:50pm

Students may leave straight after Block 2 at 12.35 pm and must sign out at the office.

Please ensure that you have notified the office if your child has permission to study at home during Blocks 1 and 3. If the College has not received permission from parents, students will be expected to attend Supervised Senior Study as normal.
