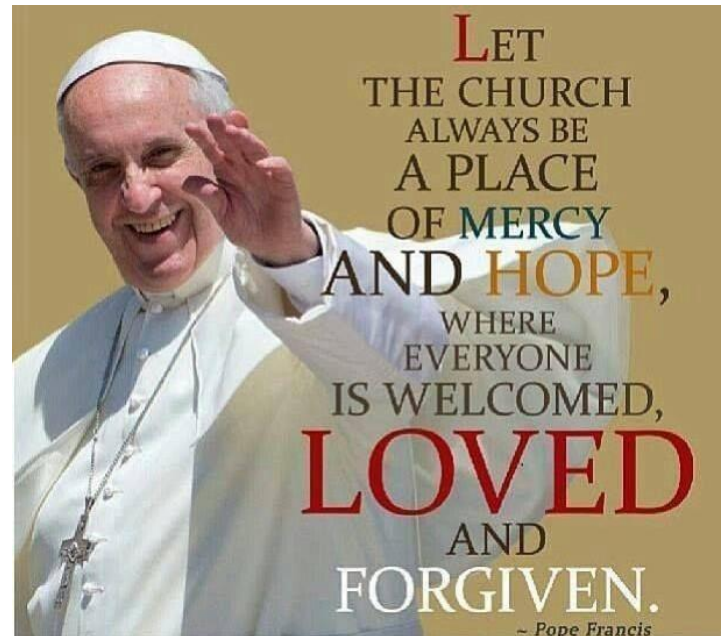
REPORTS TRIMESTER 1
