

# GREEN & GOLD CARD SYSTEM

The Campion Green (Years 10 and 11) and Gold (Years 12 and 13) cards are awarded to students who are able to manage their own learning. The programme emphasises key skills encouraged in 21<sup>st</sup> Century learning and allows students to take greater ownership over their learning.

The Gold Card allows Year 12 and 13 students flexibility to move on and off site throughout the school day during their study periods and on Fridays.

The Green Card allows Year 10 and 11 students flexibility to move within the College grounds and classrooms throughout the school day during their study periods and on Fridays.

The advantage of the Green and Gold is that students can continue working on projects or assignments with access to College facilities but without the restriction of a timetable structure. This means they can work on a project they are completing for the full day on Friday if needed.

To qualify for a Green or Gold Card the student must:

- Maintain a high standard of academic effort and commitment.
- Be actively involved in leadership within the College.
- Participate in a sports, arts or spiritual area of the College.
- Maintain a high attendance.
- Maintain a high standard of behaviour.

The full details of requirements are explained in the Green/Gold Card contract.

Parental approval is required for students to be eligible for a Green or Gold Card.

The theory behind the Gold Card concept is that if a student has greater ownership over their learning they are more likely to achieve at a high level. This is built on the concept of self-directed learning. Our NCEA results for Gold Card holders supports this theory.

- **ACADEMIC LEVELS:** All courses are founded on academic levels and not Year groups. There are four academic levels:
  - Foundation Courses
  - Level 1 NCEA Courses
  - Level 2 NCEA Courses
  - Level 3 NCEA Courses
- **SELF DIRECTED LEARNING:** We focus on students taking responsibility for their learning within a well supported environment. Students who display these qualities are recognised through our Green and Gold Card programme.

# YEAR 10

The advantages of schooling at Year 10 are that:

- You are part of the Senior School. In making this decision we have given consideration to the fact that most of our Year 10 students are beginning their fourth year of learning at Campion.
- Courses have an NCEA component. This increases your chances of gaining NCEA Level 1 as a Year 11 student.
- The flexibility of the semester structure in Year 10 means that you can change courses during the year if you find they do not suit you.
- You can work at higher levels academically if you are talented in a particular subject.
- You are supported in achieving your goals by your Learning Mentor.
